Section 4880 of the California Education Code allows governing boards of school districts to authorize students to attend public higher education classes if students would benefit from the advanced scholastic or vocational training offered by public community colleges. School districts receive full Average Daily Attendance (ADA) credit for students participating in the program if the student attends his/her regular high school for at least 240 minutes per day or receives ¾ of a full ADA if the student participating in this program attends their regular high school for at least 180 minutes per day.

Students at Buchanan, Clovis, Clovis East, Clovis North, Clovis Online and Clovis West high schools have participated in this program for the past several years. For the District to claim this additional ADA, audit forms will be required to verify that all students participating in the concurrent public higher education program summarized above are approved by the Governing Board.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a one-time retroactive payment to all eligible employees and retirees for the observance of the federal Juneteenth holiday in 2021 and 2022.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

In 2021, the President of the United States officially recognized Juneteenth as a federal holiday and in 2022, the Governor of California also recognized Juneteenth as a state holiday. This action was taken as part of a growing national acknowledgement of its importance. However, in the years 2021 and 2022, permanent-position employees whose regular work years encompassed June 19 did not receive the holiday benefit of time off or holiday compensation.

In an effort to address this loss of benefit in a consistent manner across the District, it is recommended that the Governing Board approve a one-time retroactive payment to all eligible employees and retirees whose regular work year spanned June 19<sup>th</sup> in 2021 and/or 2022. This payment addresses the missed holiday while also acknowledging their work and our District's commitment to equity and the honoring of all federally recognized holidays.

Because there is a current class action lawsuit by CSEA in motion (in which the District is named among others), restoration for CSEA represented employees will be based upon the settlement terms and process once the case is approved by the court.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE:

Fiscal impact is estimated to be less than \$405,000 per holiday totaling approximately \$810,000. That cost will be charged to the appropriate District funds.

Title: Provisional Internship Permit

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) for the recommended teaching candidate, as submitted.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The PIP is available when the employing agency knows that there will be a teacher vacancy yet is unable to recruit a suitable candidate. The expectations of the employer and the employee are higher since this individual will be the teacher of record and should be on a credential track. The focus of the document is meeting subject matter competency. Once a candidate completes subject matter competency, the candidate can be employed on a document such as a District Internship Credential. Candidate requirements include the following: (1) Bachelor's degree or higher; (2) passage of the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST); and (3) specific course work or experience, explained in detail on the PIP information leaflet.

As required by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing, employing agencies offering employment to a candidate on a PIP are required to: (1) conduct a diligent search for a suitable credentialed teacher or qualified internship teacher; (2) provide the PIP holder with orientation, guidance, and assistance as specified in Title 5 Section 80026.5 of the California Code of Regulations; (3) assist the PIP holder in developing a personalized plan (kept on file at the local level) through an agency-defined assessment leading to completion of subject matter competence; and (4) counsel the PIP holder to enroll in subject matter training. Clovis Unified School District administration hereby declares that a diligent search was conducted for suitable credentialed teachers or qualified internship teachers. Upon Board approval, District administration asserts that steps 2-4, as outlined above, will be completed.

School districts submitting PIP requests must include verification that a notice of intent to employ the applicants in the identified positions was made public. The public notice must include the following information: (1) the name of the applicant(s); (2) the assignment in which the applicant(s) will be employed including subject(s), grade level(s), and school site; and (3) a statement that the applicant(s) will be employed on the basis of a PIP. Clovis Unified intends to submit a PIP request for the following teacher candidate, contingent upon administration and Board approval:

A PIP shall be issued for one year and may not be renewed.

Lastly, public school districts must include a copy of the agenda item presented to the Governing Board of the District. The permit request must include a signed statement from the Superintendent, or designee, that the item was acted upon favorably. To assure that each permit request receives individual review and approval by the Governing Board, the agenda item may not be part of the Consent agenda.

**Title:** Resolution No. 4019 - Declaring Intention to Convey Easement to Fresno Irrigation District and Setting of Public Hearing, APN 550-020-47T

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt Resolution No. 4019 declaring the intention to convey an easement to Fresno Irrigation District (FID) and set a public hearing for installation of a pipeline and other incidental purposes regarding APN 550-020-47T. (TWO-THIRDS VOTE REQUIRED)

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Clovis Unified School District ("District") owns the real property located southeast of the intersection at North Fowler and East Herndon avenues in the City of Clovis, and bearing Fresno County Assessor's Parcel Number 550-020-47T ("Property"). The District has undertaken a public works project to design and construct new administrative offices ("Project") on the Property.

The purpose of the proposed Easement is to grant FID access to the Property to install a pipeline and to conduct water through the same, including the right of unrestricted ingress and egress. The proposed Easement would prohibit the construction of any building or other permanent structure on or the planting of any vegetative materials within the Easement area.

The conveyance of the easement to FID is authorized by the California Education Code. Pursuant to Education Code section 17556, a school district governing board may dedicate or convey to any public corporation or private corporation engaged in the public utility business an easement to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, and operate water, sewer, gas, or storm drain pipes or ditches, electric or telephone lines, and access roads used in connection therewith, over and upon any land belonging to the school district, upon such terms and conditions as agreed to by the parties. Education Code section 17577 requires the governing board, by not less than a two-thirds vote of all of its board members, to adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate or convey the easement and set a public hearing not less than 10 days thereafter on the question of making the conveyance.

The dedication and conveyance of an easement pursuant to Education Code section 17556 et seq. is a two-step process. At this October 23, 2024, Board meeting, the Board will take action on the first step by adopting the proposed Resolution No. 4019 that is attached. By adopting the proposed Resolution, the Board would declare its intention to convey the Easement to FID and set a public hearing to be held at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024. Proposed Resolution No. 4019 is attached and must be adopted by at least a two-thirds vote of all of the Board members and be signed by the Board members or a majority thereof.

The Board actions for the second step are anticipated to occur at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024. At that meeting, the Board will: (1) hold the public hearing no earlier than

6:45 p.m. at 1680 David E Cook Way, Clovis, California, on the question of making the conveyance of the Easement to FID; and (2) consider and adopt a resolution to approve the conveyance of the Easement to FID.

## DECLARING INTENTION TO CONVEY EASEMENT TO FRESNO IRRIGATION DISTRICT AND SETTING OF PUBLIC HEARING

**WHEREAS,** Clovis Unified School District ("District") owns the real property located southeast of the intersection at North Fowler and East Herndon avenues in the City of Clovis, and bearing Fresno County Assessor's Parcel Number 550-020-47T ("Property").

**WHEREAS**, the District has undertaken a public works project to design and construct new administrative offices ("Project") on the Property.

WHEREAS, the District desires to grant Fresno Irrigation District (FID) a perpetual and exclusive easement and right-of-way to construct, install, operate, use, maintain, alter, repair, improve, reconstruct, access, inspect, clean, reconfigure, redesign, traverse and/or pipe: canal(s), ditches, pipeline turnouts, gates, structures, conduits, meters, valves, measuring and/or telemetric control devices or structures, monitoring stations/devices, power lines, poles, panels and/or equipment, pumps, or any other accounterments or security structures (collectively "Utility Improvements"), including a right of unrestricted ingress and egress over and across a portion of the Property, as depicted in Exhibit A ("Easement Area"). No building or other permanent structure on or the planting of any vegetative materials, will be permitted or constructed within or over the Easement Area.

WHEREAS, the conveyance of the Easement to FID is authorized by the California Education Code. Pursuant to Education Code section 17556, a school district governing board may dedicate or convey to any public corporation or private corporation engaged in the public utility business an easement to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, and operate water, sewer, gas, or storm drain pipes or ditches, electric or telephone lines, and access roads used in connection therewith, over and upon any land belonging to the school district, upon such terms and conditions as agreed to by the parties.

WHEREAS, the dedication and conveyance of an easement pursuant to Education Code section 17556 et seq. is a two-step process. The first step is for the Board to adopt a resolution at a meeting of the Board declaring its intention to convey the easement and set a public hearing to

be held not less than 10 days thereafter. (Education Code § 17557) The second step is for the Board to: (1) hold the public hearing on the question of making the dedication or conveyance of the easement; and (2) adopt a resolution to authorize and direct the execution of a deed of dedication or conveyance of the easement and to deliver it. (Education Code § 17559) The resolutions must be adopted by at least a two-thirds vote of all of the Board members. (Education Code § 17557, 17559)

**WHEREAS,** by this Resolution and pursuant to Education Code section 17557, the Board intends to declare its intention to convey the Easement on, across, and upon the Easement Area to FID, and to fix a date and time for the public hearing upon the question of making the dedication or conveyance of the Easement to FID.

#### **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the District's Governing Board hereby:

- 1. Declares and adopts the foregoing recitals as true and correct.
- 2. Declares its intention to convey the Easement on, across, and upon the Easement Area to FID for the Utility Improvements, such an Easement as stated in Exhibit A and to be set forth in a deed of easement or other similar documents with such terms and conditions as agreed upon by the District and FID.
- 3. Fixes the date and time of the public hearing upon the question of making the conveyance of the Easement as follows: No earlier than 6:45 p.m. on November 13, 2024, the Board shall hold a public hearing upon the question of making the conveyance of the Easement to FID. The meeting shall be held at the Board's regular place of meeting, the Professional Development Building Boardroom, 1680 David E. Cook Way, Clovis, California.
- 4. The Superintendent or designee is authorized and directed to give notice of the adoption of this Resolution and of the time and place of holding the meeting at which the public hearing shall be conducted. The notice shall be given by posting a copy of this Resolution and by publishing written notice as required by law.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Because there is no existing collective bargaining agreement, the negotiation will address the mandatory subjects of bargaining, including salary, benefits and working conditions.

**Title:** Construction Costs for Increment Five of the Terry P. Bradley Educational Center

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Approve construction costs for increment five of the Terry P. Bradley Educational Center and related provisions of the lease-leaseback agreement, and authorize the Superintendent or designee to execute the schedule of sublease payments for increment five.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

At the October 6, 2021, CUSD Governing Board meeting, the Board approved Harris Construction to be the District's lease-leaseback contractor for the new 7-12 educational center and instructed the District to prepare the lease-leaseback agreement, site lease agreement and sublease agreements. Harris was also authorized to begin performing designated preconstruction services for the new educational center.

Following the October 6, 2021, Board meeting, Harris worked with the District and the project architect to perform pre-construction services including site evaluation, constructability review, design meetings, scheduling, cost estimates and construction planning.

On October 17, 2024, Harris received bids from subcontractors to construct increment five of the Terry P. Bradley Educational Center. The District participated in the bid process and prequalification of all the subcontractors to ensure that the best value is received. Following the bid opening, a two week review by Harris Construction will be conducted to evaluate best value in accordance with Education Code section 17406. A final review by Harris Construction and CUSD will be conducted on October 31, 2024. The sum of the subcontractors' bids is considered the "Total Sublease Amount" under the terms of the District lease-leaseback agreement with Harris Construction and will be set out in the schedule of sublease payments.

The bid results will be included with the agenda materials for the November 13, 2024, Governing Board meeting.

## RESOLUTION NO. 4017 BEFORE THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE CLOVIS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FRESNO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

## IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE TERRY P. BRADLEY EDUCATIONAL CENTER

WHEREAS, the Clovis Unified School District (the "District") is in the process of developing the new Terry P. Bradley Educational Center on an approximately 160 acre site between Leonard Avenue and Highland Avenue, north and south of the Clinton Avenue alignment (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in connection with the Project, the District must acquire over 50 rights of way and easements as more fully depicted in Exhibit A ("Easements") in order to accommodate the construction and maintenance of the street improvements, the installation of public utilities, the relocation of existing utilities impacted by the Project, and other related infrastructure improvements and facilities related to or impacted by the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's estimate of the acquisition cost is \$145,000 per acre; plus reasonable costs to repair, relocate or replace improvements impacted by the Project, as applicable; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the District to proceed with the acquisition of the Easements in a timely manner in order avoid any delays to the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Governing Board of Clovis Unified School District declares, finds and resolves as follows:

**SECTION 1**. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and, by this reference, incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

SECTION 2. District Administration is authorized to negotiate and sign purchase agreements for the Easements in accordance with this Resolution, execute certificates of acceptance for the Rights of Way, open escrow, if appropriate, execute any escrow or supplementary escrow instructions relating to the purchase agreements, execute any supplementary agreements related to the possession, use, ownership of the Easements or


development of the Project, and to approve any amendments in order to carry out the provisions of this Resolution and the terms of the purchase agreements, including payment of the purchase prices, plus escrow fees and costs, if applicable, as set forth in the purchase agreements.

**SECTION 3**. District's legal counsel is authorized and directed to prepare or approve all appropriate documents, opinions and instructions as necessary to carry out the terms and provisions of the purchase agreements authorized by this Resolution.

**SECTION 4**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**Title:** Resolution No. 4020 - Approving Conveyance of Easement to Fresno Irrigation District, APN 550-020-47T

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution No. 4020 approving the conveyance of an easement to Fresno Irrigation District (FID) for installation of a pipeline and other incidental purposes regarding APN 550-020-47T. (TWO-THIRDS VOTE REQUIRED)

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Clovis Unified School District ("District") owns the real property located southeast of the intersection of North Fowler and East Herndon avenues in the City of Clovis, and bearing Fresno County Assessor's Parcel Number 550-020-47T ("Property"). The District has undertaken a public works project to design and construct new administrative offices ("Project") on the Property.

The purpose of the proposed Easement is to grant FID access to the Property to install a pipeline and to conduct water through the same, including the right of unrestricted ingress and egress. The proposed Easement would prohibit the construction of any building or other permanent structure on or the planting of any vegetative materials within the Easement area. The conveyance of the easement to FID is authorized by the California Education Code. Pursuant to Education Code section 17556, a school district governing board may dedicate or convey to any public corporation or private corporation engaged in the public utility business an easement to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, and operate water, sewer, gas, or storm drain pipes or ditches, electric or telephone lines, and access roads used in connection therewith, over and upon any land belonging to the school district, upon such terms and conditions as agreed to by the parties. Education Code section 17577 requires the governing board, by not less than a two-thirds vote of all of its board members, to adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate or convey the easement and set a public hearing not less than 10 days thereafter on the question of making the conveyance.

The dedication and conveyance of an easement pursuant to Education Code section 17556 et seq. is a two-step process. At the October 23, 2024, Board meeting, the Board would be taking action on the first step by adopting proposed Resolution No. 4019. By adopting Resolution No. 4019, the Board would declare its intention to convey the Easement to FID and set a public hearing to be held at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024. Resolution No. 4019 must be adopted by at least a two-thirds vote of all of the Board Members and be signed by the Board Members or a majority thereof.

The Board actions for the second step are anticipated to occur at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024. At that meeting, the Board will: (1) hold the public hearing no earlier than 6:45 p.m. at 1680 David E. Cook Way, Clovis, California, on the question of making the

conveyance of the Easement to FID; and (2) consider and adopt the proposed Resolution No. 4020 to approve the conveyance of the Easement to FID. Proposed Resolution No. 4020 is attached.

## APPROVING CONVEYANCE OF EASEMENT AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT AND ACTIONS RELATED THERETO

GRANTEE: FRESNO IRRIGATION DISTRICT (FID)

PROPERTY: APN 550-020-47T (FOWLER & HERNDON AVENUES)

**WHEREAS,** Clovis Unified School District ("District") owns the real property located southeast of the intersection at North Fowler and East Herndon avenues in the City of Clovis, and bearing Fresno County Assessor's Parcel Number 550-020-47T ("Property").

**WHEREAS**, the District has undertaken a public works project to design and construct new administrative offices ("Project") on the Property.

WHEREAS, the District desires to grant Fresno Irrigation District (FID) a perpetual and exclusive easement and right-of-way to construct, install, operate, use, maintain, alter, repair, improve, reconstruct, access, inspect, clean, reconfigure, redesign, traverse and/or pipe: canal(s), ditches, pipeline turnouts, gates, structures, conduits, meters, valves, measuring and/or telemetric control devices or structures, monitoring stations/devices, power lines, poles, panels and/or equipment, pumps, or any other accounterments or security structures (collectively "Utility Improvements"), including a right of unrestricted ingress and egress over and across a portion of the Property, as depicted in Exhibit A ("Easement Area"). No building or other permanent structure on or the planting of any vegetative materials, will be permitted or constructed within or over the Easement Area.

WHEREAS, the conveyance of the Easement to Grantee is authorized by the California Education Code. Pursuant to Education Code section 17556, a school district governing board may dedicate or convey to any public corporation or private corporation engaged in the public utility business an easement to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, and operate water, sewer, gas, or storm drain pipes or ditches, electric or telephone lines, and access roads used in connection

therewith, over and upon any land belonging to the school district, upon such terms and conditions as agreed to by the parties.

WHEREAS, the dedication and conveyance of an easement pursuant to Education Code section 17556 et seq. is a two-step process. The first step is for the Board to adopt a resolution at a meeting of the Board declaring its intention to convey the easement and set a public hearing to be held not less than 10 days thereafter. (Education Code § 17557) The second step is for the Board to: (1) hold the public hearing on the question of making the dedication or conveyance of the easement; and (2) adopt a resolution to authorize and direct the execution of a deed of dedication or conveyance of the easement and to deliver it. (Education Code § 17559) The resolution must be adopted by at least a two-thirds vote of all of the Board Members. (Education Code § 17557, 17559)

**WHEREAS**, the Board completed the first step of the process by adopting, at its Board meeting on October 23, 2024, Resolution No. 4019 declaring its intention to convey the Easement to Grantee and setting a public hearing to be held at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, at the Board meeting on November 13, 2024, the Board will take action to complete the second step in the process by adopting this Resolution and approving and authorizing the actions set forth below.

WHEREAS, no protest has been filed under Education Code section 17560.

#### **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the District's Governing Board hereby:

- 1. Declares and adopts the foregoing recitals as true and correct.
- 2. Pursuant to Education Code section 17556 et seq., approves the conveyance of the Easement on, across, and upon the Easement Area to Grantee as set forth in the agreement between Grantee and District ("Easement Agreement").
- 3. Authorizes and directs the Superintendent or designee to: (1) execute and deliver to Grantee the Easement Agreement and other documents as may be necessary to convey the Easement to Grantee, with such modifications thereto as the Superintendent or designee determines appropriate and agreed upon with Grantee; and (2) take such actions and execute such other documents as may be necessary to carry out and complete the Easement Agreement and the transaction contemplated by this Resolution.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
