**RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the Provisional Internship Permits (PIP) for the recommended teaching candidates, as submitted.

**DISCUSSION:**

The PIP is available when the employing agency knows that there will be a teacher vacancy yet is unable to recruit a suitable candidate. The expectations of the employer and the employee are higher since this individual will be the teacher of record and should be on a credential track. The focus of the document is meeting subject matter competency. Once a candidate completes subject matter competency, the candidate can be employed on a document such as a District Internship Credential. Candidate requirements include the following: (1) Bachelor's degree or higher; (2) passage of the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST); and (3) specific course work or experience, explained in detail on the PIP information leaflet.

As required by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC), employing agencies offering employment to a candidate on a PIP are required to: (1) conduct a diligent search for a suitable credentialed teacher or qualified internship teacher; (2) provide the PIP holder with orientation, guidance, and assistance as specified in Title 5 Section 80026.5 of the California Code of Regulations; (3) assist the PIP holder in developing a personalized plan (kept on file at the local level) through an agency-defined assessment leading to completion of subject matter competence; and (4) counsel the PIP holder to enroll in subject matter training. Clovis Unified School District administration hereby declares that a diligent search was conducted for suitable credentialed teachers or qualified internship teachers. Upon Board approval, District administration asserts that steps 2-4, as outlined above, will be completed.

School districts submitting PIP requests must include verification that a notice of intent to employ the applicant(s) in the identified positions was made public. The public notice must include the following information: (1) the name of the applicant(s); (2) the assignment in which the applicant(s) will be employed including subject(s), grade level(s), and school site; and (3) a statement that the applicant(s) will be employed on the basis of a PIP. Clovis Unified intends to submit a PIP request for the following teacher candidates, contingent upon administration and Board approval:

**A RESOLUTION IN THE MATTER OF EMERGENCY CONTRACT  
WITHOUT BIDDING FOR SIERRA OUTDOOR SCHOOL  
CHANGE ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, in cases of emergency when repair or replacements are necessary, Public Contract Code (PCC) sections 22035 and 22050 provide that a governing body of a school district that has elected to become subject to the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA) may proceed at once to replace or repair any public facility, take any directly related and immediate action required by that emergency, and procure the necessary equipment, services, and supplies for those purposes, pursuant to a four-fifths vote without giving notice for bids to let contracts. Pursuant to Resolution No. 3842, adopted on February 2, 2022, the Clovis Unified School District (District) Governing Board continued its election to be subject to the CUPCCAA; and

**WHEREAS**, before a school district governing body takes any action to proceed with emergency repairs or replacements pursuant to PCC sections 22035 and 22050, it shall make a finding, based on substantial evidence set forth in the minutes of its meeting, that the emergency will not permit a delay resulting from a competitive solicitation for bids, and that the action is necessary to respond to the emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the District owns and operates the Sierra Outdoor School (SOS), located at 15700 Old Oak Ranch Road, Sonora, California 95370. The District provides opportunities at SOS for students in the District as well as those in other school districts to learn and experience nature and engage in outdoor activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the District previously went out to bid to repave a play court on site and JT2, Inc. (Todd Companies) was the low bidder at \$675,750. Todd Companies was awarded the project and commenced work on the project. Because of the nature of the project, student activities were suspended for the duration of the planned project; and

**WHEREAS**, upon commencing construction, moisture was discovered under the play surface. An engineer was engaged and prepared a remediation plan to be completed as part of the project. The District has held negotiations on the work required to complete the remediation plan for approximately \$233,650, and the District staff believes that the final negotiated change order price is reasonable; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff believes that rebidding the project while the job was underway and awarding it to an entity other than the Todd Companies would have created massive disruption and a potential claim with the Todd Companies on completing the project; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff believes that a new contractor performing the work would have caused waste and delay, which would be at the expense of the District. It would also extend the closure of SOS to students and disrupt future student activities currently scheduled; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff believes that if the District were to have bid any of this work to another contractor, the prices of those bids would be more than the price of Todd Companies' change order because it is already mobilized on the project, and Todd Companies' costs to perform the project and would remain lower than other contractors who may bid on the work; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Contract Code section 20118.4 states that a school district may, "authorize the contractor to proceed with performance of the change or alteration [to a contract] without the formality of securing bids, if the cost so agreed upon does not exceed the greater of: (a) the amount specified in Section 20111 ...; or (b) ten percent of the original contract price"; and

**WHEREAS**, notwithstanding Public Contract Code sections 20111 or 20118.4, California courts allow a narrow exception to the public bidding law in circumstances in which it would be futile, undesirable or impractical and would cause additional delay and additional cost (*Los Angeles Dredging Company v. City of Long Beach* (1930) 2 Cal. 348; *Graydon v. Pasadena Redevelopment Agency* (1980) 104 Cal.App.3d 631.); and

**WHEREAS**, California law provides that, "where competitive proposals work an incongruity and are unavailing as affecting the final result or where they do not produce any advantage . . . the statute requiring competitive bidding does not apply." (*Hiller v. City of Los Angeles* (1961) 197 Cal.App.2d 685, 694.); and

**WHEREAS**, bidding any portion of the added work will not affect the final result to the District except to further increase the cost of the project and delay its completion.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Board hereby:

1. Adopts the above recitals and findings as true and correct.
2. Finds, based on the above recitals and findings, that the above-stated conditions do not permit a delay resulting from a competitive solicitation for bids, and that the immediate actions are necessary.
3. Approves and delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to enter into the change order to complete the remedial work.
4. Delegates authority to the Superintendent and designees to negotiate future change orders to the extent the additional scope of work is required to complete the project and it would be incongruous to publicly bid the increased scope of work, subject to Board ratification.
5. Finds, conditioned upon completion of the performance of the necessary work, no further action is needed to respond to the emergency.

Authorize the Superintendent or designee to approve the updated School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) and the categorical budget for new Title I schools for the 2026-27 school year and to authorize each school to implement its categorical programs.

**DISCUSSION:**

Due to changing demographics and an increase in Title I funds, five new schools qualify for Title I funding and services. This includes Orazo, Freedom, Liberty, Maple Creek, and Young elementary sites.

The purpose of the SPSA is to create a cycle of continuous improvement of student academic performance, as measured by State and District assessments. The goal is for all students to illustrate growth and achieve at rigorous levels.

Annually, Clovis Unified schools work in collaboration with their School Site Councils and English Language Advisory Committees to develop their school site SPSA. These groups of parents and school staff collect and analyze students' performance data, set priorities for program improvement, use rigorous research-based strategies, conduct ongoing monitoring of results, and review budgets. SPSAs are approved annually by the site's School Site Council in the spring and are then reviewed and approved by the CUSD Governing Board in May/June of each school year. SPSAs for these newly identified Title I schools were reviewed at special meetings of School Site Councils and English Language Advisory Committees held between the start of the 2026-27 school year and the September 9, 2026, Governing Board meeting.

The 2026-27 SPSA is based on the State's funding allocations. A copy of each school's SPSA is currently available to interested parties for review at the school site, and upon approval, will be posted to the CUSD website.

The term of this agreement expires on June 30, 2027.

**WHEREAS**, on March 5, 2025, the Governing Board adopted Resolution No. 4035 acknowledging the five-year school facilities master plan requirement for the SFP funding applications, and the Governing Board now desires to adopt this Resolution to acknowledge the master plan submittal time frame specified in SFP Regulation section 1859.18.1(c) as it applies to the District's Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP) funding applications; and

**WHEREAS**, nothing in this Resolution is intended to rescind, limit, or otherwise modify Resolution No. 4035 with respect to any funding application other than the District's CTEFP funding applications;

**WHEREAS**, as a condition of participating in the CTEFP, as administered by the SAB, the Clovis Unified School District shall submit to the DGS a five-year school facilities master plan,

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### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt Resolution No. 4112 to recalculate the 2025-26 Gann Limit Appropriation and estimate the 2026-27 Gann Limit Appropriation.

### **DISCUSSION:**

The Gann Limit, named for Paul Gann, the author of Proposition 4 which amended the State Constitution to establish this limit, is intended to constrain the growth in State and local government spending by linking year-to-year changes in expenditures to changes in inflation (represented by per capita personal income) and population (represented by average daily attendance (ADA) for schools). Established in 1979 following the enactment of Proposition 13 and subsequently amended by Proposition 111, the Gann Limit has become a largely pro forma calculation that no longer constrains governmental expenditures. This is because the limit has grown significantly faster than appropriations subject to the limit.

Education Code section 42132 requires that on or before September 15 of each year, governing boards adopt a resolution to identify the recalculated appropriations limit for the previous fiscal year and the estimated appropriations limit for the current fiscal year.

Clovis Unified is required to perform Gann Limit calculations by the State Constitution, but it is also important for the District to complete these calculations to identify how much state aid counts toward its Gann Limit and, ultimately, the State's own Gann Limit.

The worksheet and resolution reflecting the recalculated 2025-26 Gann Limit Appropriation for the District and the estimated Gann Limit Appropriation for 2026-27 will be provided to the Governing Board prior to the September 9, 2026, Governing Board meeting.
